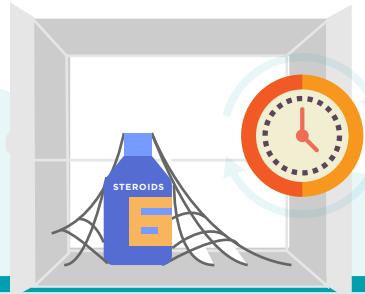


New Treatments for Nephrotic Syndrome

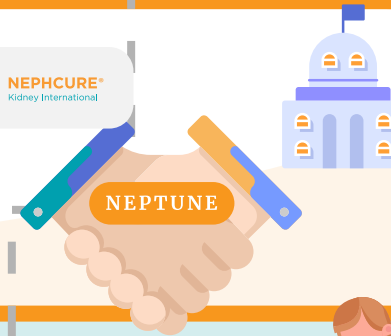
1951

Steroids are first used to treat Nephrotic Syndrome. There are **no further treatment breakthroughs** for about 50 years.



2009

NephCure and the NIH jointly fund **NEPTUNE**, the **largest investment in NS research ever at that time.**



2012

The first potential new FSGS drug fails because **not enough patients enroll** in the trial. Research in the drug is **terminated.**



2016

NEPTUNE data convinces FDA to accept **new measurements** for FSGS and Nephrotic Syndrome trials, making it **more practical** for pharmaceutical companies to pursue **new treatments.**



2019

Today, at least **16 pharmaceutical companies** are **researching treatments and sponsoring trials** for FSGS, IgA Nephropathy, and other primary Nephrotic Syndrome conditions.
