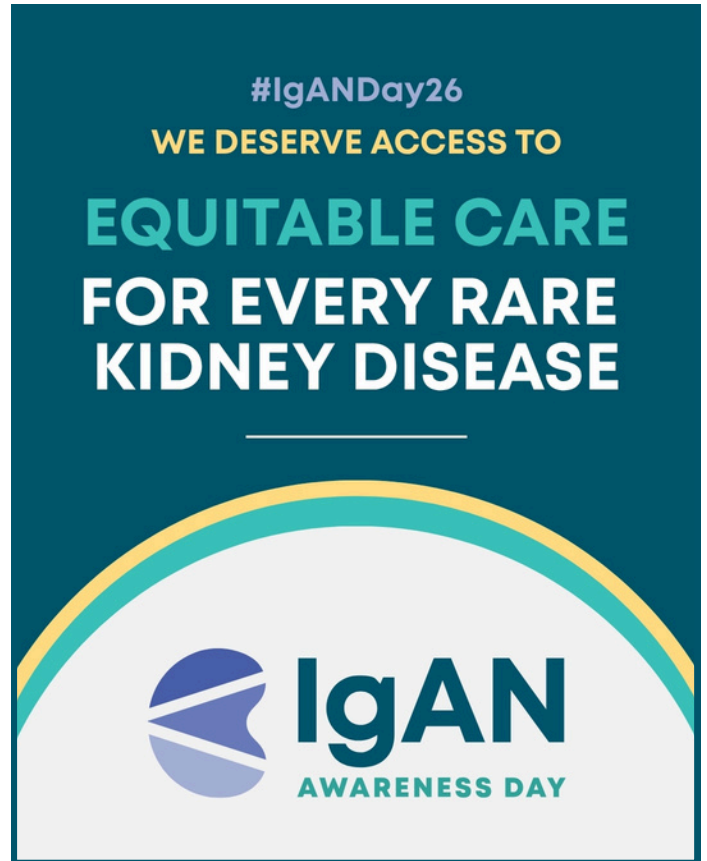
**Use your platform to educate your community, amplify patient voices, and help ensure those affected by IgAN are seen and heard.**

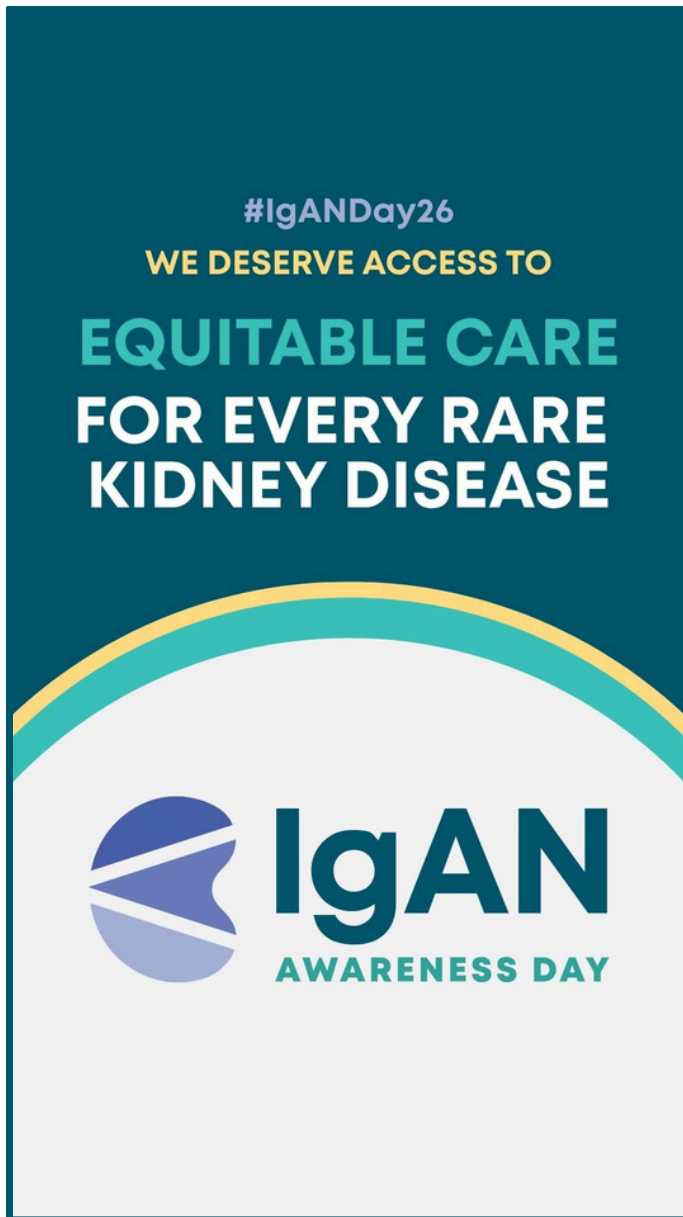
